Coral reefs cover less than 0.1% of the whole ocean surface but they support one-third of all marine species. Coral reefs are not only a critical habitat for numerous species, but also provide essential ecosystem services upon which millions of people depend. Coral reefs are at risk because of multiple stressors such as overfishing, pollution and climate change.

Active restoration includes different techniques and methods that raise as many fast and slow-growing species as possible. HOW DOES THE CORAL RESTORATION WORK?

Guests can be involved in every step of the project. The first step is to identify the corals, looking for ones that have been recently damaged. Note: It's important to avoid living corals.

Then the coral fragments need to be fixed to the frame. This may involve a dive if the frame is already underwater. New frames can be fixed on land, giving everyone the opportunity to help.

You will continue to receive updates about the progress of your coral colony once you leave. This is a unique experience and a great way to keep reliving memories of your time at Baglioni Resort Maldives.
